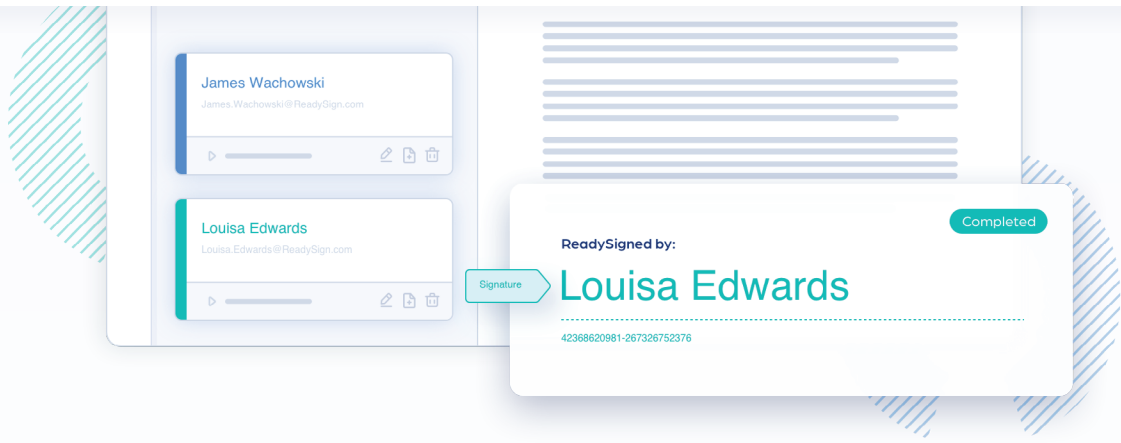


E-Sign Vs Manual Signing: Why Wet Signatures are Drying Up
